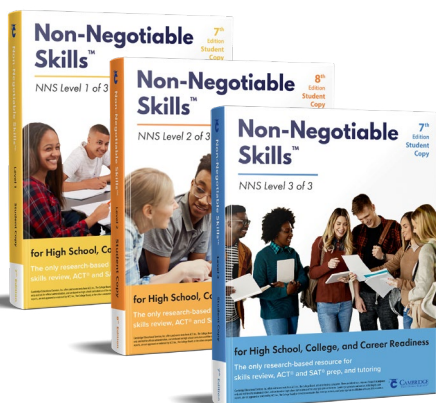

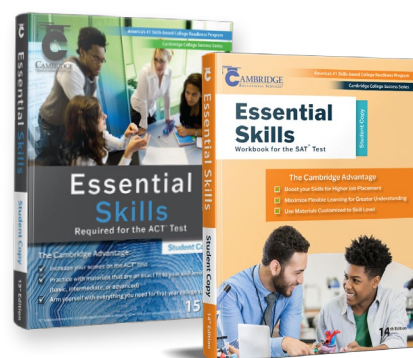


Non-negotiable Skills
